


Business Systems Analyst

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Create process maps of the current-state, identifying issues and their root causes, outlining resolutions via to-be modelling and gap analysis, specialising in processes where technical steps/systems are utilised.
- Responsible for designing and optimising the systems, in order to deliver VFM.
- Responsible for understanding the customers and colleague needs and translating into user stories & acceptance criteria that meet ICT security and architectural principles
- Responsible for improving digital experience of customers and colleagues.
- Ensures the needs, goals and behaviours of customers and colleagues are understood to inform the procurement and utilisation of systems.
- Document the functional and technical requirements in the form of User Stories & Acceptance Criteria and communicate these to both technical and non-technical stakeholders.
- Articulate business requirements at all Agile/Sprint ceremonies, and fully participating at the meetings to represent the business areas.

- Ensure any new solution has been appropriately tested (system and UAT testing) and accept & approve the product on behalf of the business to minimise and operational issues.

- Ensuring new solutions and system changes align with the ICT strategy and challenge where appropriate if solutions are not aligned to strategy, architecture, or security principles
- Working closely with Business analysts sat within Business functions to align work and ensure working collaboratively.
- Undertake additional duties appropriate to the role and/or grade.
