Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide support to the Landscape Team Manager in the development and delivery of the Estate Management policy and Tree Management procedure.
- 2. Survey, assess condition and identify arboriculture works required to trees that YHG has responsibility for, ensuring detailed records are maintained.
- 3. Issue and monitor instructions in relation to arboriculture works to contractors and monitor these contractors.
- 4. Maintain and update the spatial Tree Stock Inventory on the teams Geographical Information System (GIS) project.
- 5. Investigate tree related enquires and complaints received from residents and neighbours.
- **6.** Effectively manage Health and Safety through management of risk, identify and report issues/breaches and effectively promote a safe work environment for all.
- 7. Ensure Financial Standing Orders are followed and demonstrate value for money.
- **8.** Support YHG's approach to capturing and responding to customer feedback by taking the lead in proactively minimising and assisting in resolution of complaints
- 9. Undertake all responsibility in accordance with YHG Policy and Procedures.
- 10. Adhere to Safeguarding Policy and procedure and, where appropriate, refer customers at risk to appropriate agencies/Local Authority.
