- Ensure ownership of data and information held by the Group, that informs business planning and decision making, is accurate; providing robust, timely updates based on technical building knowledge.
- Proactive identification and capture of property related issues, considering the customer group's needs while also providing recommendations for interventions based on sound, technical experience.
- Working with regional client teams and property colleagues and assist with preparation of project proposals, including option appraisal, feasibility studies, planned investment reports, and specific defect reports.
- Support the asset handover process by carrying out site surveys, reviews of handover documentation and effective liaison with development colleagues.
- Support the development of standard operating processes, policies, and quality frameworks to ensure consistency and deliver continuous improvement.
- Support the development of strategies, policies and plans by providing technical expertise on a range of building issues and challenges to deliver the YHG vision and business plan.
- Undertake additional duties appropriate to the role and/or grade.
