- 3. Prepare Project Quality Plans and ensure that quality feedback is incorporated into the project management process.

- 5. Undertake regular site visits and attend site meetings to ensure statutory obligations/regulatory undertakings are met.
- 6. Continuously monitor work on site in accordance with Contractors Method Statements and the Construction Health and Safety Plan.
- 7. Maintain and issue regular site progress reports including contract variation instructions, quality and compliance inspections, handover progress and Health & Safety assessments.
- **8.** Prepare and attend snagging inspections and advise Project Managers and Consultants prior issuing Certificates of Completion, prepare schedules of defects and ensure they are rectified prior to expiration of defects.
- 9. Undertaking building surveys, inspections, defect diagnostics and make recommendations on the amendment of design documents.
- **10.** Ensure comprehensive timely information of completions and assets risks, undertake stock condition and validation inspections ensuring outcomes are accurately recorded on YHG's systems.
- **11.** Effectively manage site risks including CDM, identify and report any issues/breaches in relation to Health & Safety, and to actively promote a safe working environment for all.
- 12. Undertake additional duties appropriate to the role and/or grade.
